Welcome to the 8th Asian Forum on Chronobiology,

The 8th Asian Forum on Chronobiology will be held in New Delhi India on February 8-9, 2025. The Forum is co-organized with the 10th conference of the Asian Society for Sleep Research hosted by Professor H Mallick. Chronobiology is a scientific field for understanding adaptation in the periodically changing environment such as day/night and seasons, the underlying mechanisms at the molecular and cellular to the physiology and behavior levels, and for solving the issues in agriculture, livestock, industry, lifestyles and medicine. The first Asian Forum on Chronobiology was held in 2015 in Japan. The chronobiologists in China, Korea, India, Turkey and Japan got together in Sapporo and agreed to continue the Forum for further development of this science in Asia by exchanging information and ideas for future collaboration. Except for the year of COVID-19 pandemics, the Forum was held successfully in China, Japan, and Turkey.
